Graphing Calculator: TI-*nspire* CX II CAS or TI-89

You may borrow a calculator from the library for the full semester. Visit the Tech Gear Desk on the second floor of the library and request the TI-89. I recommend that you do this during the first week of school as the supply of calculators is limited. You may also purchase a calculator. This can be done through Amazon, Staples, etc.

Required Special Paper for Homework: Engineer Computation Pad.

This can be purchased at the SRJC bookstore or on Amazon. On the Amazon site, search for: ROARING SPRING 5x5 Grid Engineering Pad, 15# Green.
